



2019 - Summer Camp at The Tree House *UPDATED 2/7/19*

This summer, treat your child to an exciting adventure! Let his or her mind explore new things, dig into dinosaurs, explore the wilderness, or cook up some delicious recipes...all right at The Tree House! Children, 3 to 5 years of age, will engage in both indoor and outdoor theme-related activities designed to stimulate their imaginations.

Days are filled with exciting educational experiences*, arts and crafts, cooking, music, literature, outdoor play, games and movement that revolve around the scheduled theme. Weekly special guests are planned to supplement our themes**. Our camp is operated by trained Tree House staff with each session having a one week theme, but weeks need not be taken consecutively.

Please note that we recommend children who will be going to Kindergarten attend a program geared towards school-aged children as the Tree House is geared towards children who will be attending preschool (including 4 Plus) in the coming year.
